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System Measurement

Global License Audit & Compliance supports all customers in fulfilling their contractual duty to carry out system measurements. Measuring the system determines the number of users of SAP systems and which SAP products are in use.



License Audit Measurement Service

The scope of an SAP License Audit Measurement depends on the customer's on-Premise license entitlement. By default, this comprises the standard* user and engine measurement, and the S/4HANA measurement.

Depending on the scenario, the following measurements could apply as well:

- ✓ Self-declaration product measurement - all licensed products with a use metric that cannot be automatically measured due to the licensing model or its functionalities, for example *Revenue, Plants, Spend Volume*, etc..
- ✓ Other SAP products being measured with a specific measurement tool and therefore are not included in the standard system measurement process.
 - ✓ SAP HANA measurement
 - ✓ SAP BusinessObjects measurement with LMBI

System Data

A system represents the machine on which you have installed your SAP product or a tenant that SAP manages for your business in the cloud. It contains fields such as the Operating System you run on the machine, the SAP product you installed on it, the database associated with your product, the datacenter a tenant is located in and more.
